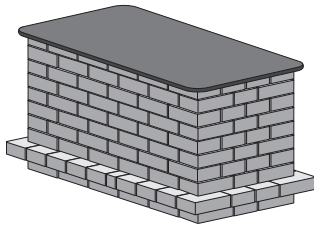


COUNTRY STONE

OUTDOOR BAR INSTALLATION GUIDE

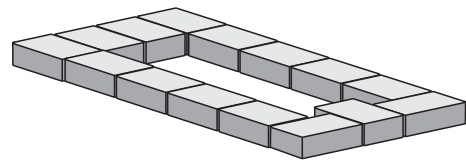


REQUIRED MATERIALS:

- 159 Country Stone Units (2 Cut Units)
 - 1 Piece of Counter Top
- Tape Measure
- Masonry Saw
- Caulking Gun & Masonry Adhesive

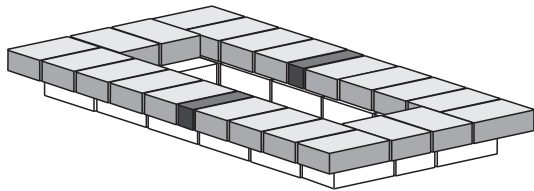
LAYER 1

- 15 Whole Block
- 68" x 32" Outside Dimension



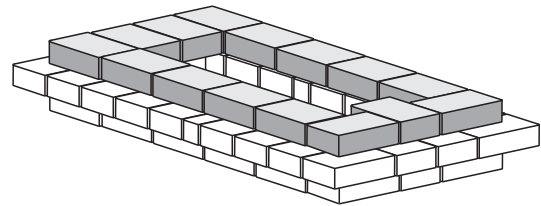
LAYER 2

- 22 Whole Block
- 2 Cut Block - 4" x 4" x 12"
- 76" x 40" Outside Dimension



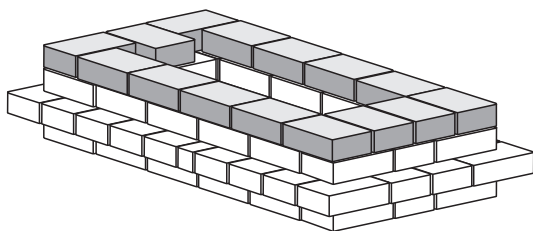
LAYER 3

- 15 Whole Block
- 68" x 32" Outside Dimension



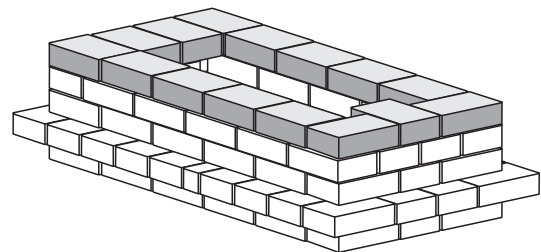
LAYER 4

- 68" x 32" Outside Dimension



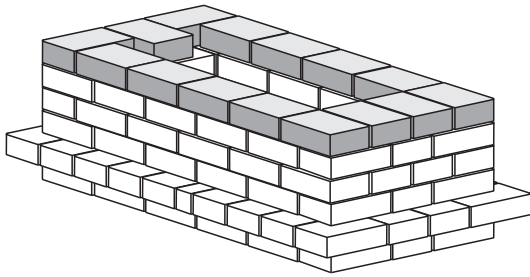
LAYER 5

- 68" x 32" Outside Dimension



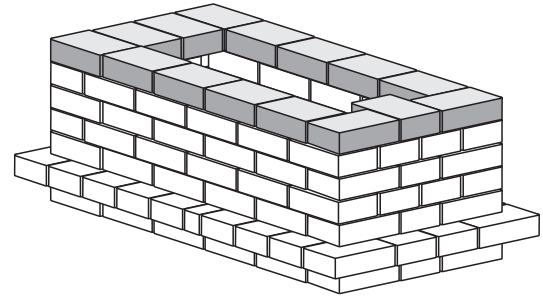
LAYER 6

- 68" x 32" Outside Dimension



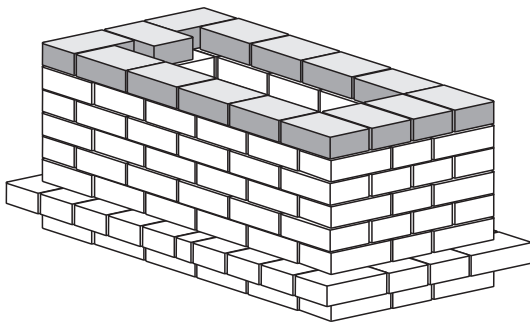
LAYER 7

- 68" x 32" Outside Dimension



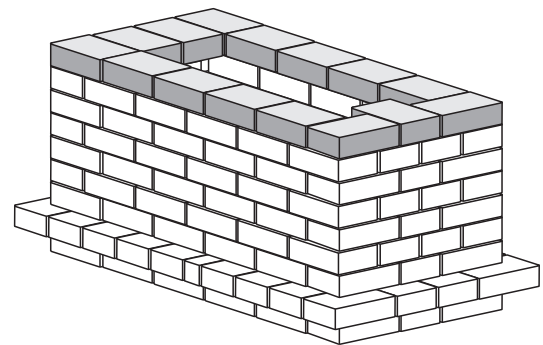
LAYER 8

- 68" x 32" Outside Dimension



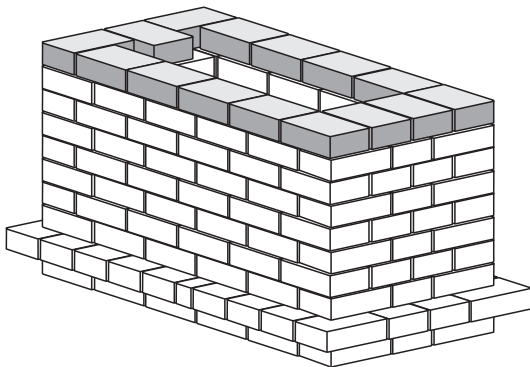
LAYER 9

- 68" x 32" Outside Dimension



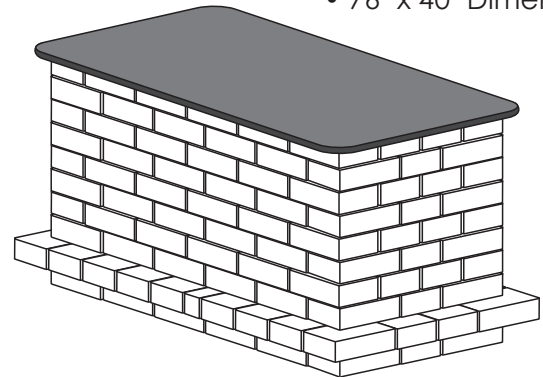
LAYER 10

LAYER 11

- Counter Top
- 76" x 40" Dimension



NOTES:

- The outdoor bar should be built on a level concrete footing
 - The footprint of the outdoor bar is 68" x 32"
 - The dimension of the counter top should be 76" x 40"
 - The overall height of the outdoor bar is roughly 41"
- The blocks can be bonded with masonry adhesive for stability
 - Blocks in this guide that appear darker represent cuts
